

PLAYER AWARD FOUNDATION

In 2007 the National Junior Baseball League (NJBL) announced the establishment of the National Junior Baseball League Player Award Foundation.

The National Junior Baseball League Player Award Foundation was set up by the National Junior Baseball League (NJBL) to benefit teams who participate in, and support, the NJBL.

The National Junior Baseball League Player Award Foundation Board is comprised of managers from the National Junior Baseball League as well as members of various communities from Long Island. As of November 7, 2007 the following persons sit on the Player Award Foundation board: Bob Bente, Glenn Confessore, Chris Derosa, Patrick LoPipero, Jan Rosenblum, Frank Sullivan and Brian Tighe.

Effective January 1, 2009, the eligibility rules for the drawing are:

1) There will be twenty (20) \$500 awards given out to teams that played in the NJBL during the past season (spring, summer or fall). The awards given out will total \$10,000. The recipient team will have the option of accepting one of the following three awards:

- \$500 NJBL voucher to be applied to a NJBL LEAGUE REGISTRATION fee to be used within one year of issuance.

- \$500 NJBL voucher to be used at Matt Guiliano's Play Like a Pro in Hauppauge, to be used within one year of issuance.

- \$500 NJBL voucher to be used at Amity Harbor Sports on Merrick Road in Amityville, to be used within one year of issuance.

2) A team may only win the award once per year.

3) The teams will be selected in a random drawing conducted by Bob Bente, Web Scoring Systems, from our web site database. Present at the drawing will be a quorum of the members of the Players Award Foundation Board.

The teams chosen will be announced at our annual meeting to be held in January, following the drawing year. They will also be posted on the NJBL web site at www.nationaljunior.com in January, following the drawing year.
